

**TOWN OF FERRISBURGH
BUDGET SELECTBOARD MINUTES
January 14, 2014**

Members present: Loretta Lawrence-Chair, Sally Torrey, Steve Gutowski, Jim Benoit, and Jim Warden

The meeting is called to order at 5:31 pm. John Bull, road foreman, was present to go over the highway budget. The biggest increase is in paving with an increase of \$20,000. He mentions that ANR is working on new requirements for the towns to follow and that we may be better off not pursuing the new rules and not receiving money from the State. Projects coming up will include Old Hollow Road and the bridge decks for Satterly and Middlebrook Roads. After much discussion it was decided to wait until next year to replace the single axle truck.

Jim Benoit moves to deposit the security deposit check for the Warner wedding last week-end since the paint on the wall in the balcony was damaged, seconded by Steve Gutowski. So voted.

Regarding the open wastewater permit for the Town Offices and Community Center, Steve Gutowski moves to withdraw the unused permits, seconded by Jim Benoit. So Voted.

Pam Cousino mentions that the radiator is leaking in the zoning office and there is a very small water leak downstairs. Jim Benoit says he will contact Avonda regarding the radiator leak.

Sheila McGregor does not have to file rabies certificates with the Town but she is willing to file them with us upon written request.

The meeting is adjourned at 6:50 pm.
