**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
ADDISON COUNTY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION
REVIEW OF FERRISBURGH TOWN PLAN**

The Addison County Regional Planning Commission (ACRPC) and Ferrisburgh Planning Commission will hold a joint public hearing on October 18th, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at the Ferrisburgh Town Clerk's office to review the Ferrisburgh Town Plan, which was recently adopted by the Selectboard. The Town of Ferrisburgh has requested that ACRPC grant regional approval of their Town Plan pursuant to 24 V.S.A. § 4350(b). The purpose of the review is to determine whether the Ferrisburgh Town Plan:

1. is consistent with the goals established in 24 V.S.A. § 4302;
2. is compatible with its regional plan;
3. is compatible with approved plans of other municipalities in the region; and
4. contains all the elements included in 24 V.S.A. §4382.

The Ferrisburgh Town Plan encompasses the entire Town of Ferrisburgh. Copies of the Ferrisburgh Town Plan can be viewed at the Ferrisburgh Town office on Route 7 in Ferrisburgh and at ACRPC's Office at 14 Seminary Street, Middlebury.
