Craig opened the meeting at 7:30pm.

Craig moved to accept February's minutes as amended, Dennis seconded; all voted in favor.

A. We resolved to continue looking into Wildlife considerations within our Town Plan.

B. We discussed the upcoming H223, a shoreland protection bill. There is a public hearing tonight in Montpelier. We understand the bill will be rewritten.

C. How will the new stormwater regulations going into effect affect the Town?

1. For already permitted projects, 1 sq. foot of disturbance will bring it under the new regs.
2. Our Town Zoning doesn't have any additional jurisdiction with the new regs but we don't know how this will affect town road maintenance like ditching.

D. Proposed Vt Gas pipeline thru Monkton.

1. Craig talked with Laura Farrell gathering info to advise town on environmental impacts.
2. Wildlife passage construction money is available.

John left the meeting at 8:20.

E. Clark Hinsdale submitted a zoning application to construct a bridge over Lewis Creek for agriculture, recreation, and forestry. The application is "for compliance."

No other business was discussed and the meeting adjourned at 8:40. The next scheduled meeting is April 9, 2013.
