Deb opened the meeting at 7:40pm.

John moved to accept the minutes of October's meeting as amended; Karen seconded the motion; all voted in favor.

Craig joined the meeting.

A. Town Forest

1. If we don't get the boundary signs posted in the Town Forest this fall we will resume in the spring with help from Dennis' Boy Scout troop.
2. Brent Jerger received a verbal from the Selectboard to continue using the snowmobile trail.
3. Discussed early succession area improvements with advice from the county forester. The Lake Chaplain Maritime Museum or the Ferrisburgh Community Woodpile could be end users of the wood.

B. No official notice of the status of the farm conservation project.

C. Deb will send an email to Ken Wheeling and Bob Beach and ask what's happening with the zoning rewrite started in 2009.

D. Karen reports many camps on Long Point are being raised up to the 105' line to avoid flooding issues. We questioned how some of those camp septic systems performed though the recent Spring floods.

E. Discussed the 750' buffer around vernal pools.

No other business was discussed and the meeting adjourned at 8:30. The next meeting is December 13, 2011.
