

Ferrisburgh Trails Committee Meeting Minutes

Date: April 10, 2023

The meeting commenced at 7:00 PM in the Ferrisburgh Town Hall.

2. **Municipal Planning Grant** – The grant has been approved by the State. The grant will be worth approximately \$25,000. The funds will help the Committee create a planning document, a master plan, to develop and maintain trails and other transportation resources in Ferrisburgh. Courtney will meet with Steve True, Town Zoning Administrator, about the next steps.
3. **Courtney attended the March meeting of the Conservation Committee.** She introduced herself to the Committee. She told the Committee that the Trails Committee is here to help and that we would be willing to collaborate on projects of mutual interest.
4. **The Trails Committee is planning to set up a table** at the Taste of Summer event in Ferrisburgh organized by the Friends of the Union Meeting Hall. The event will be held on May 19th and 21st.
5. **Ancient Roads** – There was general discussion about ancient roads in town and their potential as trails. Pam Cousino, Town Clerk, knows a lot about ancient roads in town. Annie will try to coordinate a meeting with her so that the Committee can learn more about this subject.
6. **New Business** – none
7. **Old Business** – Robert will get in touch with Lisa Thornton of the State to see if we can get an update on potential trail funding for the western section of Kingsland Bay State Park.
