## ***PUBLIC ACCESS TO FERRISBURGH TOWN FOREST***

---

The only formal public access to the Rowland Robinson Memorial Municipal Forest ["Ferrisburgh Town Forest"] is across the privately-owned parcel located southeast of Robinson Road and west of the Town Forest. This access is allowed by the right-of-way included in the deed when the "Town Forest" parcel was bequeathed to the town by Elizabeth Robinson in 1962. There is no described or surveyed location of any specific route for the access to the Town Forest across this private property.

## ***THERE IS NO TRAIL OR PATH TO THE TOWN FOREST***

---

The Town asks that anyone accessing the Town Forest across this adjacent private parcel travel only on foot [no motorized vehicles], and that they respect the privacy of the owners of the private parcel.

The walking route suggested by the Ferrisburgh Conservation Commission from Robinson Rd. to the Town Forest is described below, and is shown in yellow dashes on the maps accompanying this text:

1. Park at the right-angle corner of Robinson Road, not on the travelled portion of the road, and not blocking the driveway that heads south from here, to the private residence.
2. Walk south from Robinson Rd., then turn left [east] up the driveway. Skirt the garage and house to the left [north], staying close to the north property line. At the base of the steep cliff, turn right [south], and follow the base of the cliff south, crossing the wetland and stream. Turn left [east] across the stream, and enter the Town Forest on the woods road.
3. The Town Forest boundaries are blazed in pink paint on trees, and there are yellow metal boundary signs.



3. The Town Forest boundaries are blazed in pink paint on trees, and there are yellow boundary signs.
