

Town of Ferrisburgh Right of Way/ Utility Permit

PERMIT CONDITIONS: Applicants must note the following special conditions. However, in general, all projects must adhere to the Highways Standards for the Town of Ferrisburgh. the Town of Ferrisburgh reserves the right to shut down any project deemed unsafe or not complying with this permit.

- 24-hour minimum notice to Town Highway Department is required prior to commencement of construction.**

- Construction Activity will be allowed from April 15 until October 31 unless warranted by an emergency.**

- waiver may be granted by the approval of the Highway Department.**

- Contractor must call Dig Safe 800-344-7233 Dig Safe approval # _____**

- Hours of Work _____**

- Roads, ditches, culverts, etc., will be restored to the condition found at the start of construction.**

- This permit provides no private right of way.**

- Permittee will be responsible for any engineering costs incurred by the Town for inspections deemed Necessary outside the realm of the Road Foremen's responsibility.**

- Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) Signage & Registered traffic control technicians.**

- Be aware of all culvert crossings.**

- Bore _____ in. /feet below road elevation.**

- Bury conduit _____ ft. below road elevation.**

- Starter and receiving pits to be no closer than 10' from the edge of pavement.**

- No materials left on traveled lanes overnight.**

- No open excavation left overnight.**

- The owner/contractor are completely responsible for all Vermont Occupational Safety Health Administration Compliance**

- Vibratory compaction equipment to be used during backfill.**
